All Deep Freeze tasks can be created and executed immediately or scheduled for a future date.

The Deep Freeze Snap-in for Novell ConsoleOne supports workstations running Windows 98, 2000, and XP that have Deep Freeze 6.3 installed. Specific requirements for individual components are listed in the user manual.
