Deep Freeze Mac Wins Macworld Magazine's 2006 Editors' Choice Award

Deep Freeze provides a completely non-restrictive working environment where there is no need to be concerned about system misconfiguration, or malicious damage to a system; a simple restart eradicates all changes and restores the machine to its original pristine state. The standard system configuration is available at all times and IT maintenance is dramatically reduced. Editions for Windows and Windows servers are also available with a Linux edition coming soon.
