

Ensure system security and eliminate vulnerabilities in your network by keeping your software up to date with the latest security patches from Microsoft and third-party vendors.

Automate application and OS updates, instantly detecting endpoints that have outdated applications or missing OS patches, and create policies to automatically Approve, Deny or Defer updates for specific Applications and Windows Update Categories.





Remotely connect to endpoints in any location to troubleshoot or chat with end users. You can even transfer files between computers

IT Administrators can choose to view and take full control of endpoints or choose to shadow a user to assist with setting up an application, printer or help carry out other tasks that require IT assistance.





The Microsoft System Information Tool (MSINFO32) provides an extensive summary of your system hardware, installed device drivers and installed software. You can use this comprehensive view of hardware, software environment and system components to diagnose issues on endpoints.

If a software vendor requires an investigation and needs to reproduce an issue in their lab, the MSINFO report can be used to set up a system that closely matches the configuration of your computers. Using our web-console, administrators can quickly retrieve the .nfo report from remote machines to check for compatibility issues, replicate hardware/software environments for troubleshooting, or gain extensive knowledge about a machine's current status with respect to hardware or software.



5 See What's Installed On Every Computer

A full application inventory report in real-time makes it easier to find applications that are out of date and identify rogue applications that can compromise security.

Detect unwanted applications quickly and find out which user ran an application,

for how long, and remotely uninstall any unnecessary applications.



Monitor Usage of Your IT Assets

View detailed Application and Computer Usage Reports based on computers

or users. This helps identify anomalies in usage to ensure users are adhering to your organization's guidelines.

Quickly find out which computers are online, which ones have pending application updates or Windows updates, and export these reports to CSV, HTML, or PDF for the desired time period.

Keeping track of IT hardware and understanding hardware location, configuration, and usage is a vital part of planning IT changes effectively.

Get a real-time Hardware Inventory Report that includes details on Operating Systems, Disk Usage, Network and User Settings and hardware - including service oriented details like Manufacturer, Service Tag and Model Numbers.





Reclaim Space From Temp Folders Remotely

Low disk space can cause sluggish performance, increased load times, issues with applications running smoothly and even render machines unusable due to OS and Application crashes.

Reclaim Disk Space by clearing temporary files and emptying the Recycle Bin. You can set this up as a repeatable action that can be performed in one click without the need to go to a machine or remote into it making it extremely easy to ensure machines are kept clean and stay that way.

Disable Hibernation and Free Up Space on SSDs

The Hibernation file (hiberfil.sys) can take up a lot of space. In some cases, it can use up storage space equivalent to the amount of RAM installed. Remotely deactivate hibernation or limit the hiberfil.sys file size to reclaim that valuable disk space. You can also enable Hibernation if required.





Send Custom Notifications to All Your Users from Anywhere



Send out notifications to users to share links, perform followup tasks, watch a video,



display reminders while working remotely.


Send out notifications to users with your company logo, allowing users to Snooze the notification without moving away from the application they are currently working on. These notifications can be scheduled to go out at a certain time.

Disable Startup Items to Speed Up Login Time

Windows 10 doesn't really finish "booting up" when the logon screen is presented. It continues to work in the background, loading applications that are in the Startup Items folder.

Remotely select startup items that are necessary and disable the rest to allow for faster logon times.





Fine-Tune Windows Firewall Settings Remotely

Making changes to Windows Firewall Settings and Defender settings remotely comes in handy when adding a new application to the environment. Remotely add program exclusions, firewall inbound/ outbound rules or turn on/off Windows firewall instantly.



B Auto Lock Computers After a Certain Period of Inactivity

A user moving away from a PC for an undetermined amount of time without locking their screen is a common occurrence.

You can remotely set all or selected endpoints to Auto-Lock after a certain period of keyboard and mouse inactivity with a pre-configured customizable script.





Remotely Rename Computers for Easier Identification

Rename computers after the users or teams that they are assigned to, or to any other naming convention that your organization may require.


This can be done for all computers in one click with a simple from/to list passed from the console.



15 Customize Wallpapers and Start Menus on All Your




